## ARTICLE II. POLICE DEPARTMENT\*

**Sec. 66-26. Department created; supervision by chief.**

There is hereby created a police department, the head of which shall be the chief of police appointed by the city manager for an indefinite term, and removable by the manager. The chief of police shall be an officer of the city, and shall have supervision and control of the police department. (Code 1974, § 22-1)

**Sec. 66-27. General duties.**

It shall be the duty of the police department to apprehend and arrest on view or on warrant and bring to justice all violators of the ordinances of the city; to suppress all riots, affrays and unlawful assemblies which may come to its knowledge and generally to keep the peace; to serve all warrants, writs, executions and other processes properly directed and delivered to it; to apprehend and arrest persons violating federal or state law as provided by law, and to turn them over to proper authorities; and in all respects to perform all duties pertaining to the offices of police. (Code 1974, § 22-2)
